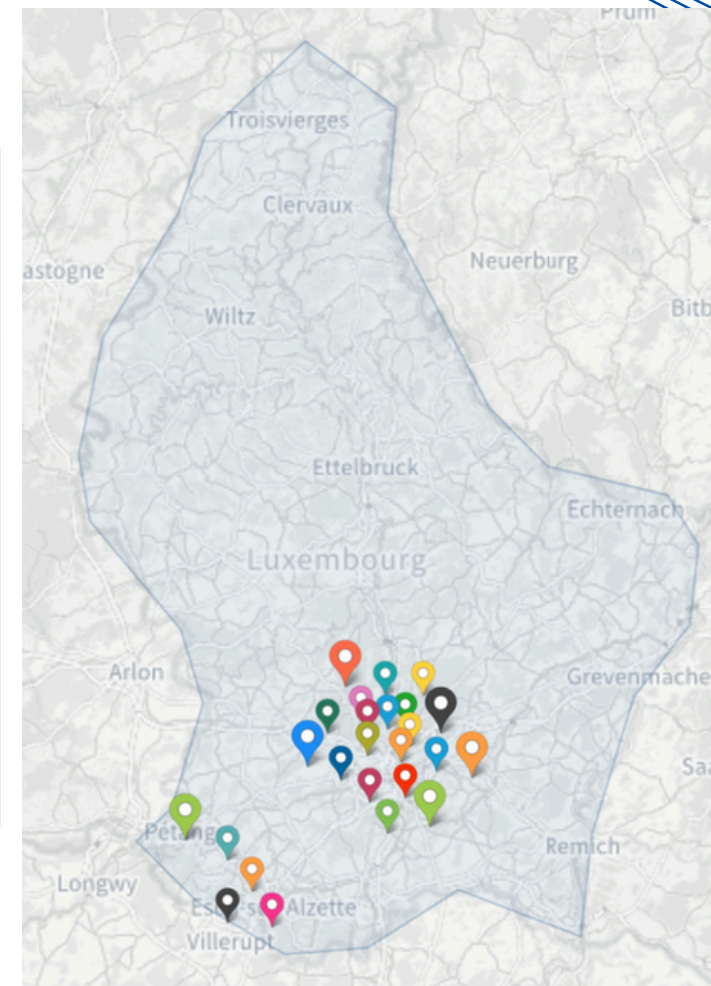

### Selection procedures for contract staff positions

Contract staff play a key role in supporting the work of the institutions, bodies, and agencies of the European Union.

They help with temporary administrative tasks or supplement in [specialised fields](#) where additional skills are needed.

The European Personnel Selection Office (EPSO) organises selection procedures for contract staff, also known as **CAST Permanent**. **CAST** stands for Contract Agents Selection Tool, and **Permanent** refers to the fact that applications are open at all times through a continuous registration system.

#### Main steps of the selection process

- 1. Application**

The selection process for contract staff is based on **continuous registration** — you can apply at any time.
